Cover Page Rubric

Directions: You are to create a “Book Cover” for each unit at the completion of the unit. Imagine that the front is like the front of a book and the back is like the back of a book. The front should catch the “reader’s” attention and the back should give a brief synopsis of what they would learn by reading. The “text” of the book is all of your notes, handouts, writing samples, etc. from class and homework. Logistically, the Cover Page will go at the beginning of each unit in your notebook and serve as a summary of what you learned/produced! Follow the specific directions below...

Content...	<p>Front of Cover must be Creative and include... (1-4)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unit title and AP themes (3, list and define) applicable to unit • Include “Top 10” Key Terms from the Unit (define these terms) • At least 3 illustrations or computer generated visuals of pictures and captions, timelines, or maps indicative of unit content. • Illustrative examples of AT LEAST 3 themes from the unit (using text or visuals). Specify and explain the theme in writing. • Must be neat and in color
Craftsmanship...	<p>Cover must also be : (1-2)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Neat and Free of Errors • Organized • Reflective of the main ideas of the entire Unit in a creative way
Summary...	<p>“Back” of Cover should include: (1-4)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Summary</i> of the unit in 7-10 sentences • Writing piece should be hand written or typed on the back of your Cover • Writing piece should use terms, identifications and events discussed in the chapter (minimum of 10) • Terms are to be highlighted
